Online Escape Room

The digital escape room is set in a dystopian future where democracy is under threat. Participants are tasked with reclaiming the "Orb of Europa's Light", a symbol of democratic values, from the dark character of "The Silencer". Each trial within the escape room presents participants with a series of interactive puzzles and tasks.

It is published in the <u>project website</u>, with the video introduction to the story also available in <u>Youtube</u>.


