A friend of yours have send you a screenshot of your photos and name from a dating app. You are not on any dating apps, and you have never been.







In monthly report you have noticed that a few hundred euros were spent on perfume, but you haven't bought any perfume this month.

In a period of one week, you have got many strange calls with questions about the car you are selling. Guess what? You have no idea what they are talking about.






You have noticed that some strange messages were send to your Facebook friends, but you haven't sent them yourself.
