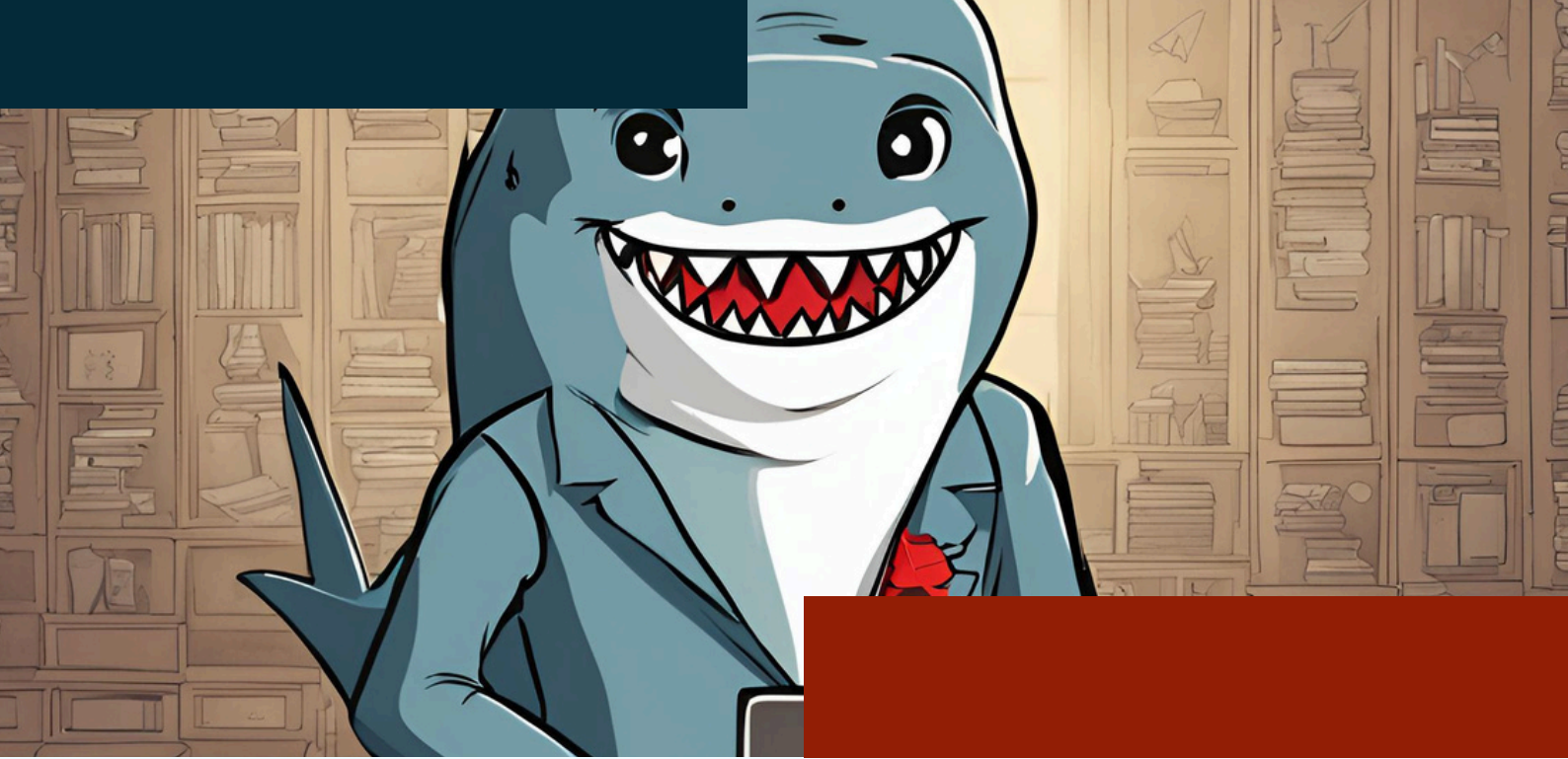
LIGHT HOLOGRAMS: REVIVING ARCHITECTURAL HERITAGE THROUGH ILLUMINATED ART
