

THE PROJECT

Warming up is a training course that addresses the urgent need for a holistic response to climate change. There is a growing sense of "climate depression", especially among young people who see no hope for meaningful change or only futile ways to channel their efforts. This project aims to engage both active participants and those who have not yet found their role and to encourage a shift away from a passive attitude.

OBJECTIVES

Expand participants' and youth's knowledge of climate change based on scientific facts.

Develop specific skills and provide proper tools that contribute to a positive impact on climate change.

Shift attitudes towards climate change, seeing it as a threat to the entire planet and not only to humans, fostering a renewed relationship between people and nature.

We will use the 3H (Head - Heart - Hands) model to ensure a holistic and

approach to the topic.

Knowledge (Head) - educating about climate change with scientific facts.

Attitudes (Heart) - changing perceptions to see climate change not just as a human problem, but as a global threat to life on the planet, focusing on the relationship between people and nature.

Skills (Hands) - providing practical skills to explore possible actions and make a positive impact.

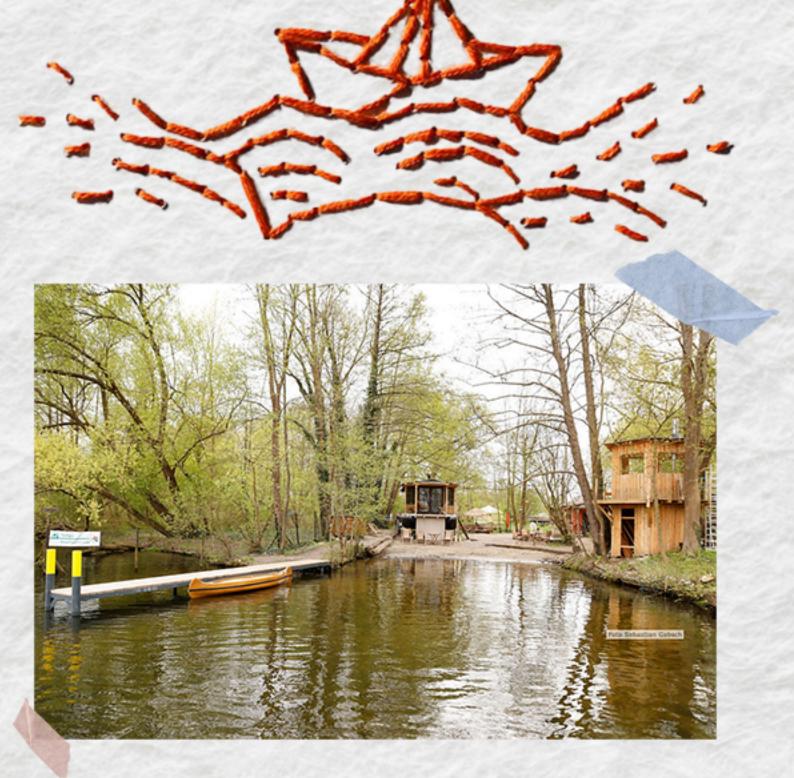




ACCOMONDATION

ACCOMONDATION

They are equipped with everything you need for a comfortable stay. Nevertheless, please bring your own sleeping bag. TRAVEL





Travel to Berlin.

You can travel up to 2 days before and 2 days after the project. If you travel green, this will exceed up to 4 days. You will need to get to Berlin, from where you will take the local transport to Potsdam, Intitut für Agrartechnik. From there, the project venue is only 10 minutes away by foot.

Maximum reimbursement per distance (the distance band is calculated from the official address of the sending organisation and the hosting location).

Participants must use environmentally friendly means of transport for the majority of their journey to be eligible for Green Travel.

Participants will be reimbursed at the end of the training course after submision of all original travel documents, including return train, bus and shuttle tickets, which must be sent by post if they are not digital.
