


Context ↘

In the field of non-formal education and youth work, artistic forms of expression are significant tools for self-development, self-exploration and self-discovery. They support us to connect with ourselves and with others. In formal educational settings, young people are required to focus on their performance. They are afraid of making mistakes, which generates and increases inner anxiety and blocks their creativity.

The project focuses on improving group learning processes applying improvisational and artistic methods by welcoming mistakes with a positive attitude, strengthening self-confidence and freeing creativity. Holistic approach to learning will be used combining different elements of arts such as movement, drawing, music, visuals, and theatre. We will have the opportunity to work with our inner dancer, painter, musician, performer and storyteller.



↙ Aim



The aim of this long-term training course is to empower those who work with groups of young people to be confident and free in experiencing and using improvisational and artistic methods as a tool for personal and professional development in youth-work, training and facilitation. Introducing and combining improvisation with artistic methods as an innovative non-formal learning method will contribute to the quality and improvement of youth work.

Objectives



to rediscover improvisation skills of youth workers/educators/trainers through artistic methods (theatre, dance, music, painting)



to learn and experience how to use artistic methods while working with young people to improve and foster self-confidence and release their creativity



to reflect on their own learning as youth worker through the experience of artistic methods (connection to the inner artist)



to create a space for the participants to design, implement and evaluate experimental learning activities



to create a network for sustainability of the idea by cooperating and creating new projects

This training is for you if you...

- ➔ are a youth worker, youth leader, member or volunteer of youth organization
- ➔ are a teacher, educator with/ without formal education background, youth trainer, mentor
- ➔ work with youngsters on local, national or/and international level
- ➔ are eager to learn something new, contribute with your experience and knowledge
- ➔ are playful, active and simply believe in the power of non-formal education



Structure

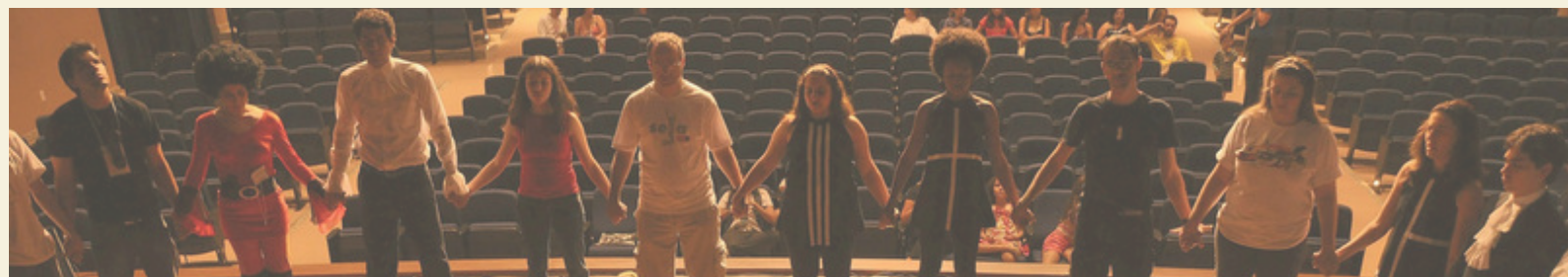
There will be 2 training courses in 2019 for the same participants, one in Hollókő (Hungary), the other in Ommen (Netherlands). There will be a practical/online phase in between.

The **2nd phase** will be practical. Each participant will implement their ideas on the theme in the local youth work.

The **1st phase** will focus on learning and experiencing artistic methods and developing improvisational skills that will guide to personal and professional development as well as developing idea(s) for the online learning or local community work.

In the **3rd phase**, the group reconnects, shares experience, goes deeper into artistic methods and youth work and reflects on their identity as trainers, facilitators and youth workers.

Applicants are required to take part in **both** activities and all phases!



Trainers

GOHAR GHANDILYAN

Gohar is a youth project coordinator, trainer and facilitator with a professional background in peace studies. She has held training courses on personal development and movement, peace education, human rights, inclusion, civil courage, gender equality etc.

GERGELY KISS

Geri is a trainer and facilitator in both business and youth sectors. His special fields are improvisation, creativity, entrepreneurial mindset and interpersonal communication. He is a member of Grund Theatre in Budapest.

Venues

The participants will stay in Creative Space training center in Hollókő, Hungary.

Hollókő is a small village located in North-Hungary, 100 km from Budapest. It is part of the UNESCO World Heritage. Creative Space is equipped with 4 bedded rooms which all have its own showers and toilets. In the building of the group accommodation, you can find the training room, dining area, common social areas. (<http://kreativter.hu/en>)

Activity 1

Ommen, Netherlands, is a small city approximately 130 km from Amsterdam and about 20 km from Zwolle.

The rooms in Olde Vechte Mansion have 2-4 beds, shared bathrooms and toilets. Training room, kitchen and common social area are in a separate building in a proximity to the accommodation. (<https://oldevechte.com/>)
