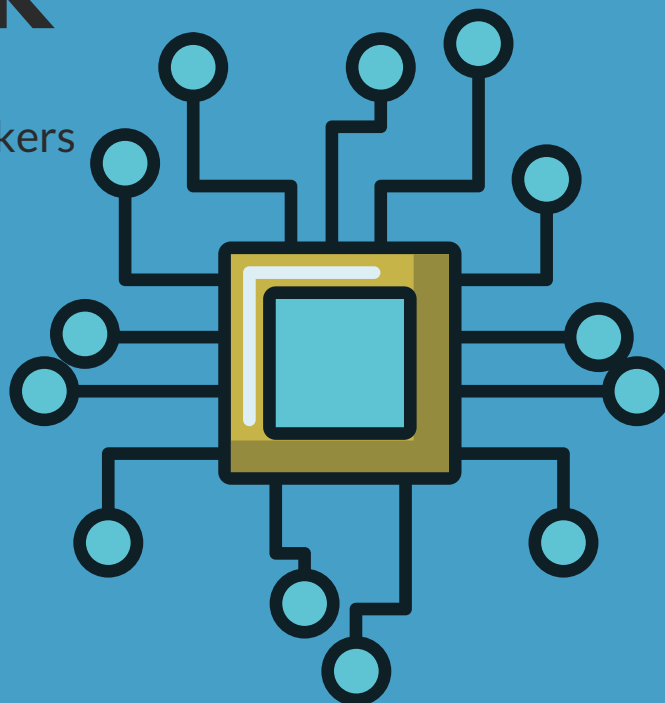

Both meetings will take place in Education and Training Centre in Rabka-Zdrój (60km away from Kraków)

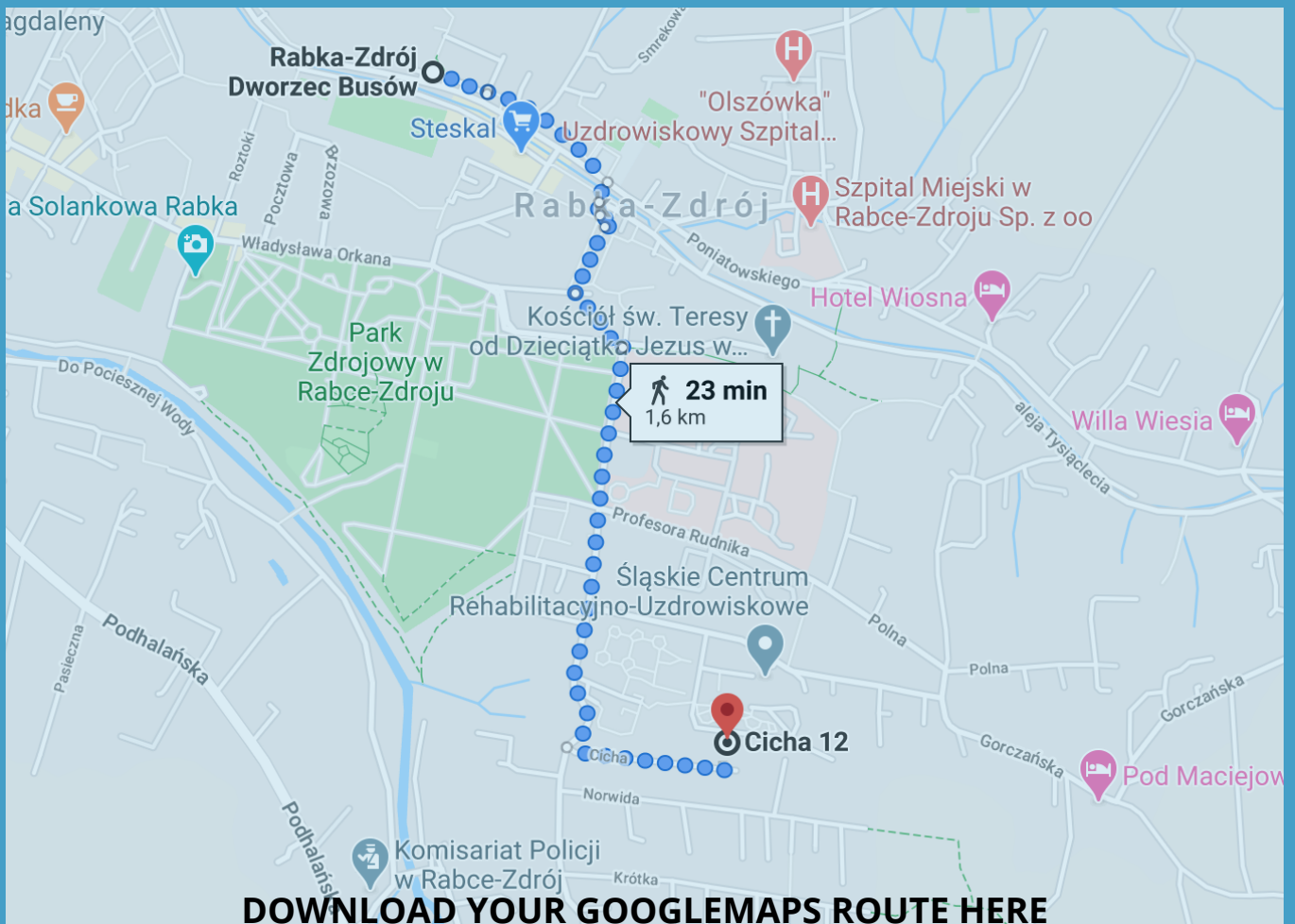
Address: ul. Cicha 12, 34-700 Rabka-Zdrój

# COVID SITUATION AND RULES



The situation in Europe due to pandemic of coronavirus has been intense for the last few months. We adapt to current situation and track statistics of new and active cases making sure that all what we do follows official regulations and recommendations of governments and World Health Organisation. Please, consider your attendace and monitor your health status and we will do our best to maintain health safety during the project.

## **What rules we will follow:**

- 2 persons per room,
- 2 meters of distance in the seminar room,- ventilated common spaces,
- 2 meters away between tables in the dining room + options of sitting in the garden, in the rooms, or by the pool,
- the whole building of the venue available just for us,
- constant disinfection of common spaces and hands,
- masks are not requested, but recommended,
- checking temperature every day,
- reimbursement of travel costs in case of early leaving due to health issues,
- private travel to the extent it is possible..

# THE TRAVEL

## How to get there?



### If you come from Kraków Airport:

Please land in **Kraków Airport** and take the train to the main Bus/Train Station (**Kraków Główny**).



Go to **Małopolski Dworzec Autobusowy** (Main Bus Station) and find "Rab-Bus" or "Edmar" bus companies going to Rabka-Zdrój. It takes 1 hour to get to this town from Kraków and costs ~ 14PLN.

### Direct bus from Kraków Airport:

**FlixBUS** is cool option to get from Kraków Airport directly to Rabka Zdrój (you book your ticket only online): [www.flixbus.pl/](http://www.flixbus.pl/) Prices depend on the time when you book it - the sooner the better.



### Where you are in Rabka-Zdrój:

From the main bus station in Rabka-Zdrój there is still 23 minutes of walking. Take this walk or call us to pick you up (option available if we're informed in advance and have car available).

You can take Taxi there (they stay just next to the station), but we **cannot reimburse taxi, nor Uber** (check out Travel Reimbursement Rules). It would have to be on you.

## Travel costs



Please buy your tickets in cooperation with your sending organisation. You don't have to consult your booking if you come on arrival day and depart on departure day.

If you pay for tickets more than the travel costs limits below, we will reimburse you the amount of the limit.

*275 EUR: Estonia, Greece, Latvia, Macedonia*

*20 EUR: Poland*

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Reimbursement of your costs will be transferred **at your sending organisation bank account** upon original tickets and invoices! Please keep also boarding passes. After each meeting every participant will be asked to fill in the reimbursement form attaching their tickets and send them by traditional post to us (we need originals)! If you have online tickets, please print them (we would have to do it anyway).
