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


1. Project description

Dear partner organisations and Participants!!

Welcome to our Training Course **Europe's Musical Interconnection**.


-Provide knowledge tools and insights that will allow you to continue your research personally in the future.

2. Participant's profile

The Background and profile of participants is the following:

- 3 participants per country
 - age 20 and more
 - strong interest in Music and Musicology: Musicians or music lovers who know how to play an instrument, at least at a basic level (and can take it with them, except in the case of pianists where we are committed to offering a keyboard or similar)
 - basic knowledge of music theory (not mandatory but strongly recommended)
 - youth workers, educators or youth musical event organizers
 - motivated to discover Europe through Music
 - youth workers interested in applying their passion for music to their work with young people
 - participants with fewer opportunities; economic or social obstacles, or belonging to cultural minorities.
 - English knowledge (minimum level A2)
 - No need to have participated to European project before.
 - Newcomers are welcome.



Chiari is a small town in the north of Italy in the province of Brescia. It's located at an altitude of 138 meters above the sea and has approximately 18,900 inhabitants. The city covers an area of 38 square kilometers, it's only a few kilometers from the river Oglio, 25 km from Brescia, 35 from Bergamo, 66 from Milan and 90 from Verona while about 20 km to the shore of Lake Iseo.
