

ICT&SM4CA training project was developed based on the key premises:

- ICT and Social media offer a lot of space for creativity, invention and imagination in developing youth led projects.
- ICT and Social media as a growth industry that can open wide doors for more entrepreneurship careers during and after the outbreak of *COVID-19*.
- Young people are pioneering in the use of ICT and SM today and can be inspired for more effective and positive outcome of this global platform, in addition that youth leaders might learn how to use ICT and social media to engage young people more systematically.
- Active participation of young people is always in need for new initiatives and creative approaches and ICT and social networks are a great field to be explored and developed.

The main aim of the project is to develop competencies of youth workers to support active civic participation of young people in community contexts through productive use of ICT and social media tools and methodologies.

The project has two main themes: Active civic participation of young people and ICT & Social media, and its main objectives are:

- To explore civic participation from participants own experiences, resources and opportunities available to address issues of concern through democratic, civil and civic engagement;
- Develop, improve and reinforce the digital skills of the youth workers and how to use them in the context of educating youth using non-formal methodologies;
- Explore possibilities for utilization of ICT& social media for youth activism;
- Reflect on non-formal education, its methods and their applicability within ICT sector and social networks;
- Equip the youth workers and the partner organizations with the mindset and the ability of designing workshops tailored to the specific needs of their target;
- Develop creative and attractive ways to apply ICT and social media solutions for youth activism, with a special emphasis on civic engagement;
- Identify local opportunities for community engagement and to design and develop a booklet for use of ICT's and social media in the local contexts.

HEMMERSHEIM, GERMANY

THE HOST

Lindenhof Hemmersheim

We are a family run farm. For our daily work and larger projects, we lump all our creative ideas together and combine our strengths and our know-how, because together ideas can be put into practice so much better. We are supported by our volunteers and volunteers of the association.





In our apartments you can watch the farm trees - apple, pear, walnut, apricot, almond, beech and of course linden trees - grow, bloom and bear fruit and listen to the cheerful chirping birds singing. Come at the right time of year, delight the trees with rain of flowers, delicious fruit or falling nuts...

In our fields, we want to show what soil-building, biodiversity-promoting and carbon-storing agriculture can look like. Fruit trees, hedges and flowering meadows are to be found around all our fields and also in the field (agroforestry).

The nearby forests invite you to the most beautiful walks or hikes at any time of the year. It is especially beautiful in spring, when bush anemones give way to wild garlic and the first leaves dance on the trees. It is not uncommon to see deer or hares scurrying past here...











THE BUDGET

There is no participation fee.

Food, accommodation and local travel costs (only during the activity program) will be covered by the grant from the National Agency of Germany of the Erasmus+ Programme.

REIMBURSEMENT

According to the rules of the National Agency of Germany, travel reimbursements can only be made by bank transfer to the Partner Organization and based on real costs.

The bank transfer will be executed after receiving all of the original documents (receipts, invoices, boarding passes and reimbursement claim) by post, filling the form generated by the National Agency online evaluation through the Mobility Tool by all the participants, dissemination of results, up to the budget limit set by the Erasmus+ Programme.

RULES FOR REIMBURSEMENT:

- 1. Only the cheapest means of transportation will be accepted between the country of the Partner Organization and the venue. Before purchasing anything, please, send your travel plan to slobodan.antic12@gmail.com for confirmation. Participants will be reimbursed based on the least expensive route, based on real costs (we can only reimburse tickets which price you can prove with invoices). Please keep in mind that we do not accept invoices of taxis or from travel agencies.
- 2. Reimbursment will be done only to those participants who participate in all activities during the training course and respect the rules of the hosting organization.
- 3. Only uninterrupted travel expenses incurred within the activity start and end dates can be accepted for reimbursement. If you wish to stay in Germany or at the venue longer and you find tickets for the same or lower value with those on the actual travel dates, then you can travel one day prior, or one day after the training course as well. However, if participants decide to arrive earlier or stay longer (up to 2 days), all costs related to that will be supported by the participants themselves.
- 4. 4. In order to avoid unnecessary stress and problems (e.g. loss of documents by the post) please send us scanned copies of all documents by email to slobodan.antic12@gmail.com before sending those by post. Please note that no flight tickets will be reimbursed if the original or electronic invoice is not provided as well.
- 5. All expenses must be converted to euros using the official exchange rate of the European Central Bank (ECB) on the date when the expense was paid. Link to ECB: http://www.ecb.europa.eu/stats/exchange/eurofxref/html/index.en.html
- 6. In case the participant(s) fail(s) to engage in the activity's daily program due to late arrival or early departure and not attending 100% of the sessions, the amount granted per participant per day will be deducted from the travel reimbursement. The maximum limit to be reimbursed for each participant is highlighted above and was calculated by the distance calculator of the European Commission.
- 7. Costs of insurance are not eligible and will not be reimbursed! This means that each participant must support his/her own insurance that covers: travel insurance (including damage or loss of luggage) wherever relevant; accident and serious illness (including permanent or temporary incapacity), as defined in the ERASMUS+ Programme Guide.

COVID-19 response

Proof of complete vaccination for all particioants in english language is required! Application forms received from potential participants who have not been vaccinated will not be considered.

The hosting organisation will provide a detailed protocol against "Covid- 19" during the project. Where it will be detail explained how things will be arranged and what measures are in place.

In case some of the participants is infected with the Covid-19 virus during the project, the organisation will provide a safe isolated room and will cover the treatment, food and accommodation for those participants during the treatment.

During the training course, it is mandatory for all participants to follow all the instructions regarding the kovid 19 pandemic presented by the hosts, which will be in line with the current situation and current government regulations in the host country.

PASSPORT AND VISAS:

Please make sure that your travel documents (passport of ID) are valid for at least 6 months and take care that you have a proper insurance (travel health/accident insurance)! In case you need VISA to enter Germany please let us know so we can assist.

Foreign citizens may enter Germany with valid passports. Visas are not required for all EU, and shengen citizens. If you need more information on the Visas and custom regulations visit the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Germany.

WEATHER:

Weather in April mainly is nice. Around 15 degrees Celsius or higher. However, please do have something warmer in case it gets cold, because it can be cold during the night.

THINGS TO BRING:

- Some traditional snacks, food, music and drinks. (intercultural evening can be organized in case you as a group want to organize it).
- Representative materials about your sending organization (brochures, CD's, etc.).
