ABOUT PBA

ABOUT SERBIA

Serbia, situated in Southeast Europe, is characterized by diverse landscapes including fertile plains, rugged mountains, and the winding course of the Danube River. Its central location in the Balkan Region makes it a key crossroads between Central Europe and the Mediterranean, shaping its history, culture, and strategic significance. *(just to be sure you are heading to the right country ... 😊)*



PEOPLE

Serbians love social life, cultural events and they are generally very good hosts (*unique and special, as most people in the world*). Their 'stereotype' is to be of impulsive reactions (a bit), but that ... is really a matter of perspective and interpretation.

LANGUAGE

In Serbia, people speak Serbian (*not to be confused with similarities with Croatian, Bosnian or Montenegrin language*) 😊 The locals (mostly youngsters) speak English, but they appreciate that you make an effort to speak at least HVALA (thank you) in Serbian. Even though basic English is well understood, this also provides the local community some good hearted laughs with your Serbian trials.

MONEY

The national currency in Serbia is dinar (RSD). You can easily exchange Euros in dinars at the exchange office (exchange rate is 1 Eur ≈117.5 RSD) and there are lots of cash withdrawal machines.

THE WEATHER

In October, Serbia typically experiences cooler temperatures as autumn progresses, with average highs ranging from 10 to 18 degrees Celsius depending on the region. Expect fresh mornings and evenings, with occasional

rain showers as the country is moving from the warmth of summer to the chill of winter. Just to be sure: bring along warm clothes and rain equipment.

ABOUT NOVI SAD

Novi Sad, is the second largest city and administrative capital of autonomous region of Vojvodina, situated on the banks of the Danube River in northern Serbia, has a rich history dating back to Roman times when it was known as Cusum. Throughout the centuries, it passed through the hands of various empires including the Ottomans and the Austro-Hungarian Empire before becoming part of Yugoslavia in the 20th century. Today, Novi Sad is a vibrant cultural and economic center, known for its picturesque architecture, bustling streets, and renowned music festivals such as EXIT. Novi Sad, the second largest city in Serbia, has been awarded the title of European Youth Capital in 2019. It has become the European capital of Culture for 2022.
