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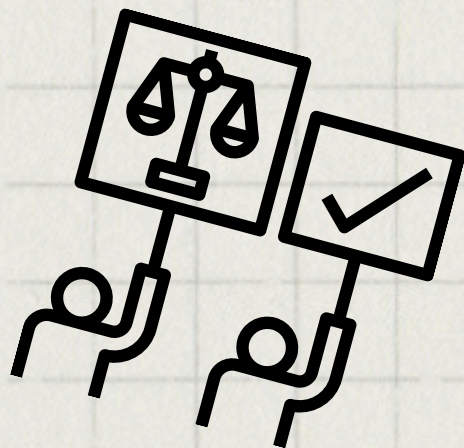

Project Description

Aim



Improve the digital competences of youth workers to enhance collaboration, management, and the reach of our and our partners' youth activities.



Objectives

- 01. Equip 17 youth workers and partner staff with necessary digital competences in the field of transnational collaboration, project management, and Dissemination and Exploitation of Results (DEOR).
- 02. Explore new digital approaches to engage young people in the activities organised by the partners.
- 03. Establish a digital infrastructure for the partner organizations and enhance their digital processes for an improved transnational cooperation.

Profile of participants

The target group of this activity is represented by youth workers and staff with a background in youth organisations and with previous experience or interest in developing experience in organizing youth exchanges in the context of E+. This TC is addressed to participants from Programme Countries, who aim towards a structured, strategic approach concerning increasing their digital competencies to improve their transnational collaboration, project management and DEOR activities.

The minimum age requirement is 18+ years old and the minimum level of English is B2.

The total number of participants is limited to 17.

Location

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The training will take place in Mezőbereny, a small town which lies in the Panonian plain, very close to the Romanian border and about 200km away from the capital Budapest. More about the town you can find [here](#).

For the accommodation, we will face the facility of Picnic Park Mezőbereny— which has an area of 1600 square meters. The Leisure Center satisfies all our needs for learning, active recreation and relaxation.

Accommodation will be arranged for 2 to 4 persons/room, grouped by gender. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be served at the same location every day, plus the coffee breaks. Each room has its own bathroom. There are no towels provided by the accommodation unit, so please make sure you pack your own.



Travel:

For travel you are bound to consult us before buying tour travel tickets. Failing to do so will result in the ineligibility of your travel expenses.

You must also procure a valid travel insurance (which is part of your co-funding to the event). You will receive more info about travel once you pass through the selection process.

Costs

Most of the costs like training, materials, accommodation, food, your most economic travel, are all covered by the Erasmus+ programme of the EU. Rest, such as insurance, single room accommodation, travel upgrades such as priority, checked-in luggage, 1st class tickets, etc. are, to be funded by you. EU does co-found, not fully fund this event, therefore you must contribute.
