# ABOUT PROJECT

The project aims to develop outdoor skills for the participants and equip them with a series of helpful methods in implementing learning experiences in outdoor education.

At the first stage of the project Participants will be trained in order to fully understand the potential of outdoor education. The knowledge and skills obtained at the project will help the participants to make their activities engaging and safe.

The program of the second stage will be built on the experience from the first stage and it will continue it, by preparing participants to implement complex and structured indoor and outdoor education activities.

## MAIN OBJECTIVES

- Develop outdoor skills for the participants (camping, hiking, orienteering, climbing) and equip them with a series of helpful methods in implementing learning experiences in OE
- Encourage personal growth and self-reflection and develop a greater sense of purpose and direction
- Promote teamwork and leadership as values in youth work
- Raise awareness and consideration for a healthy and active life style and the benefits of OE
- Empower youth workers to cover this topic with target groups





# PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

- Be educated or employed in the field of youth work
- Have some experience in outdoor/scout methods
- Age: above 18
- Be healthy enough to participate in the activities
- Have at least an intermediate level of English
- work directly with youngsters and be motivated to support your mental & physical wellbeing
- Readiness and availability to get involved in the project actively and dedicate time and effort to it
- willing to improve your level of lifestyle and to increase your competencies in outdoor activities and Projects
- Note, that there have to be the same participants for both stages, so please make sure when selecting, they are available for both dates of the project;
- Each group has to include at least one participant with fewer opportunities





# ACCOMMODATION

- For first stage, participants will be settled in camping site in Manglisi (site will be equipped with kitchen for cooking, water, electricity, waterproof tents, sleeping bag, sleeping pad);
- 3-4 people will share 1 tent;
- Participants will have to carry their essential gear with them along with tents during 2 days hike;
- Participants should be ready for maximum 15 km distance (both ways) for a 1 day hike;
- Participants should be ready for maximum 35 km distance (for both ways) for a 2 days hike;
- For second stage accommodation will be indoor, in Barcani, Covasna, around 50 km from Brasov. (more detailed information will come with the technical infopack for second stage)

# PROJECT COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENT

Participation fee 20 Euros for each stage. The fee will be paid on each stage in cash.

- 100% of accommodation, food and transportation during the project will be covered with the support of ERASMUS+.
- Only the most economical transportation (2nd class) will be reimbursed. It is necessary for participants to have travel and health insurance (not covered by project).
- Reimbursement of the first stage will be done during second stage, after the original documents are submitted. And reimbursement of the second stage will be maximum 4 months after the second stage.
- Tickets for the first stage have to be purchased no later than 20th of May, 2024;
- Tickets for the second stage have to be purchased no later than 20th of July, 2024;

Plan your trip well and choose the best means of transportation. Especially short distance can be often covered by a bus or a train, and flights can be avoided. Travel light, take only as much as you really need.

You are allowed to take maximum 2 extra days out of the project dates before or after the each stage of the project, on your own expenses.

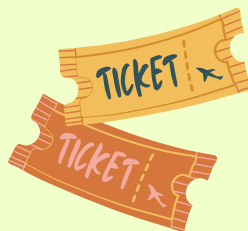
Please send us your flight tickets for approval before purchasing them!!! **DO NOT BUY WITHOUT OUR APPROVAL!!!**

Departures flights should not leave earlier than 12 o'clock on 4th of November.

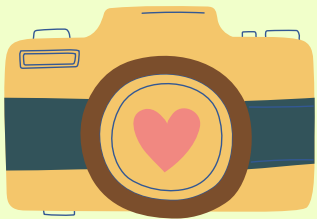






# PRACTICAL INFO
