







EUROPE@DJHT – 18th German Child and Youth Welfare Congress

"It's about the big picture: making democracy happen by participating"

DJHT, also referred to in German as Deutscher Kinder- und Jugendhilfetag (German Child and Youth Welfare Congress), is the biggest child and youth welfare summit in Europe. The Child and Youth Welfare Association (AGJ) organises a DJHT every three to four years. 30.000 youth workers, youth policymakers, (youth) researchers, and representatives from other relevant fields from all over Germany and Europe attend this huge meet-up. It is a place to exchange opinions and experiences and to learn, develop, and discover new perspectives. DJHT comprises two complementary components, a **conference** and an **exhibition space**.

What's in it?

We will set up an exciting four-day programme, **12 May 2025 – 16 May 2025**, built around the questions of what challenges youth work has to face and what youth work can offer in these times in Europe. All Europe@DJHT events can be attended in both English and German.
