The seminar provides an in-depth exploration of discrimination and racism, targeting structural and institutional inequalities. It is aimed at trainers, educators, and individuals committed to fostering an anti-racist environment.

The goal is to raise awareness of various forms of discrimination, dismantle prejudices, and develop concrete strategies for action. Participants will focus on practical approaches to solidarity, using discrimination-sensitive language, and fostering respectful communication. Best cases will be discussed, examined, and developed to ensure effective solutions across Europe and the world. A key objective is to counter the rise of right-wing narratives across Europe.

The seminar will be held in English. Participation is free of charge.

Up to six participants from other European countries are also invited to take part. Travelling expenses for participants from other European countries can be reimbursed up to 275.00 euros per person on presentation of the relevant receipts.
