No advance payments will be made to partner (sending) organizations, with the exception of participants with few financial opportunities (fewer opportunities, economic obstacles), situation that will be addressed individually.

all travel costs involved for the arrival of the participants in the hosting location will be reimbursed to the participants / sending organization based on the following documents:

DOCUMENTS

- Original tickets (or photos/scan) showing price and name of the participants (or partner organization), including boarding pass.
- Invoice (from the sending organization) or Request for refund (from the participants) signed;

TRAVEL REFUND

The reimbursement will be made into the account provided on the invoice from the sending association, or the Request for refund from the participants, by bank transfer.

All reimbursements will be made up to the maximum amount approved by the grant, taking into consideration the travel distance band. Any amounts exceeding the grant will be covered by the participant/partner organization (if the case).

The travel refund will be issued after PiGreco-SEMI receives the completed Participant Report.
