

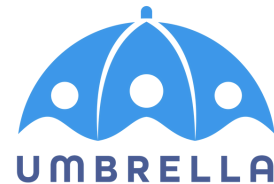

## Task 2

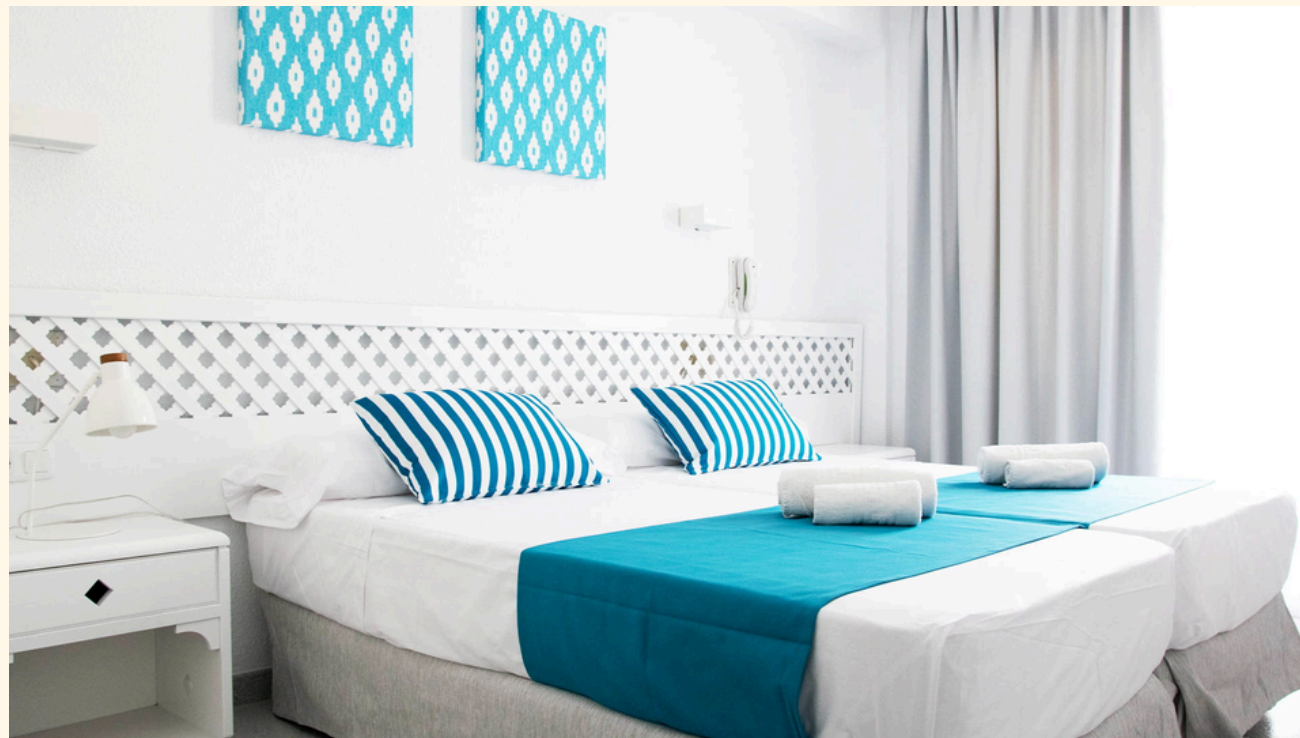
Review basic information about the other participating organizations to understand their work and focus areas (will be shared later).

# Accommodation

The Partnership Building Activity will be held on Mallorca, in the hotel BLUESSEA Mediodia. Participants will be accommodated in double rooms with all basic facilities, including private bathrooms. Essential items, such as towels, linens, hairdryers or shampoos will be provided. The accommodation costs with 3 times meals and coffee breaks will be fully covered by the project.





# Travel arrangements:

Each participant is required to buy the travel tickets, which will be reimbursed after the project, in the concrete limits, depending on the distances.

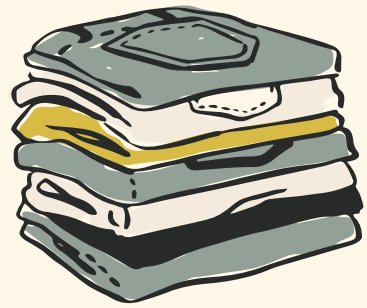
To get the information of the exact travel reimbursement limit, check the **distance calculator** and corresponding table.

Travel distance	Standard travel	Green travel
10 – 99 km	23 EUR	
100 – 499 km	180 EUR	210 EUR
500 – 1999 km	275 EUR	320 EUR
2000 – 2999 km	360 EUR	410 EUR
3000 – 3999 km	530 EUR	610 EUR
4000 – 7999 km	820 EUR

The reimbursement is only possible, if you will present. all of the tickets, invoices, boarding passes and buy the tickets only after our confirmation. Taxi costs will not be reimbursed.

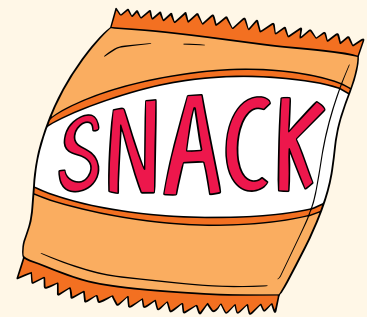
# What else?
