Thousands of women, children, elderly and millions of people need psychosocial support as they try to recover from the devastating effects of the earthquake. The psychosocial support center established in Kahramanmaraş in cooperation with Humadica provides support to the survivors. The center provides individual therapies and psychoeducation. The center meets the standards required to provide mental health services and supports all age groups.

MHPSS Project in Hatay
