The facility of the Sociedade de Historia Natural is located in Praia de Santa Cruz, Torres Vedras. The region is quite a popular and touristic place. The institution has several places for office, laboratory, and storage rooms. Regarding be hosting organization, SHN will use the biggest building that we have in Praia de Santa Cruz. The building has 4 big individual rooms, 2 different bathrooms, and toilets, 1 big kitchen and living room. The place fairly has good conditions up to 8 people. On the other hand, the institution has other accommodation options in the other town which name is Cambelas. There is a good quality house there and some of our volunteers can stay there. Each place has a fully furnished kitchen with all equipment for cooking. So the meals should be cooked by volunteers. But once or twice a week we will organize dinners and lunch for all. It will be our like catering. So, it means our institutions will make payments monthly or weekly for volunteers' kitchen expenses. This payment will be split from their pocket money and travel, transportation payment. For the local transportation we will provide monthly bus tickets for long term volunteers. But for the 1 or 2 week exchange projects we will provide our cars and small minibus from the municipality for transportation of the all volunteers even lift them from airport and return back them to airport. We have strong collaboration with Municipality and local bodies. So just in case of any issue in the logistic, we are able to solve it

quickly. Our activity locations are very common place in Portugal. It is just between 60-45 minutes from Lisbon center and will be more faster because we will provide transportation between activity place and bus stop of the region.

Why do you want to carry out this project? What are the **issues and needs** are you seeking to address through this project?

In general, our project aimed at the protection and sustainable management of all endangered natural heritage in the world. The main reason for this is that the whole quality of life depends on nature. It is a project idea that aims to integrate social life with nature. It will be a project that draws attention to the fact that we should not only benefit from nature for our human purposes, but also live as a part of nature. Continuity and sustainability of nature, human and it means continuity in other lives, so we see nature as a part of ourselves and try to fulfill our purposes and We can establish our plans in this direction on a more solid and scientific basis. For all the mentioned activities, Sociedade de Historia Natural has 5 separate departments to which professional contribution can be made. If we talk about these; -Paleontology and Ecology Laboratory -Geographic Information Systems, Geography Department -Library and Social Unit Department -Education and Training Department -Culture and Archeology Department Each department is represented by people who are experts in their fields and have scientific competence. For this reason, it is obvious that it will be able to provide a high level of dedication and material support for all activities to be carried out on issues such as climate change, ecology, ecosystem, land degradation, biodiversity, nature management and for the protection and sustainability of natural resources, and it will add a unique experience to the volunteers. This project, which both teaches and offers different perspectives to support the objectives of the European Solidarity Program and development plans, aimed to draw attention to the importance of nature and to help us understand nature. Sustainable management of social interaction with nature as well as social awareness on this issue is aimed. In this way, how does the culture of lifelong learning and research make our future plans continuous and sustainable? and a scientific-based project idea was born, proving that it will transform itself into a system that constantly updates itself. This project actually will have a co-op with ESC Project which is 2020-3-TR01-ESC11-096674. Because both projects aims to awareness in climate action. In this way, it is an indication that both projects have taken a step towards their sustainable goals. In case of support with the grant, this sustainability will be carried to higher levels and new projects will continue to be produced with greater collaborations. We aim to raise awareness with these projects.

Young people taking part within the exchange will learn how to utilize common techniques and mindfulness of geological elements in standard of living which can empower them to emphatically interface with individuals from other nations and foundations to extend cohesion. The change will straightforwardly influence young people. As the official language of the extension is English, this will too give ceaseless practice to move forward their English level all through the complete usage of the extent. It is our common goal to lay the foundations of future cooperation as two organizations that understand the importance of natural balance and natural heritage well, so we are confident that we will ensure the regular continuation of our mutual projects after the successful acceptance of this project.
