- 4. To provide young people with training and capacity-building opportunities to enhance their skills in health advocacy and climate change mitigation, enabling them to design and implement local projects that address health inequities exacerbated by climate change.
- 5. To ensure the inclusion of diverse and marginalized youth in the project's activities, empowering them to lead interventions that address health disparities and promote equitable health outcomes in the face of climate change.
