Our association was founded by a group of young people from Morocco, Denmark, and Belgium who returned to their homeland after living in Europe to start organizing work camps and long-term projects for people with fewer opportunities and combat social exclusion. MamAfrika Organization works in collaboration with European Commission Programmes. It is certified by the Ministry of Youth and the Ministry of the Interior within the organization of international volunteers and cultural exchange in Morocco.

MamAfrika Organization is a member of UMAC (Moroccan union of work camps association), FAL (Anna Lindth Fondation Morocco), and Associations space UMAV, (Maghreb union of volunteering action). MamAfrika Organization is also a partner in International Voluntary Organisations.

What MamAfrika Organization expects from you?

Normally last from 2 weeks to 2 Month, and each one has about 10–20 volunteers coming from different countries. Projects are often in remote areas, in regions where local people may have minimal opportunity for meeting others from different countries. The volunteer groups bring new ideas and experiences into local communities, providing a stimulus for ongoing local initiatives.

The individual volunteers benefit from the interaction both within the group and with the local communities. The international work camps give them the opportunity to travel to another country, use their time productively and make a positive contribution to a local community. They also have the chance to widen their horizons through meeting and learning from each other and other cultures.

Gender Equality

In many countries, LGBTI people do not receive the support they need. Often, they must hide their sexual orientation and gender identity. Or worse, they experience violence and threats from the surrounding community. LGBTI migrants who are in transit or host countries may also face prejudices or discrimination. To raise awareness of LGBTI matters, MamAfrika organization staff was trained LGBTI-trainer on the protection of LGBTI people for staff members as well as the broader humanitarian community.
