

Evgenia's volunteering also takes the form of serving the Municipal Youth Council of Thessaloniki, for the Committees on Gender Equality, and Environment and Sustainability, and being a very active member of Thessaloniki Pride's volunteers, holding a coordinating post for Thessaloniki's 2024 EuroPride.
