Project title	<i>SIMulation Youthreach Emancipation (SIM Your Emancipation)</i>
Call for proposal	Erasmus + 2015 KA1 – exchange youth program
Project objectives	<p>The aim of this project is to produce a joint reflection among young people and about a range of key competences which are required for those young people with fewer opportunities. This range of competences are based in skills linked with self – esteem as well as self-confidence and feeling of pride in themselves. Youth people needs to gain in capabilities to be independent and be enough autonomous to face new initiatives with guarantees.</p> <p>In this project is expected to do two interchanges with young people from 18 to 30 years in two intercultural interchange actions: one in Cuenca, Spain (eight days for joint training, simulation and reflections about emancipation aspects, barriers, problems, opportunities, tips,...) and second in another country with similar interest.</p>
Information about lead partner	<p>Cuenca is a Spanish city located in the region of Castile La Mancha with about 60.000 inhabitants. Cuenca was declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Youth Department of the Municipality of Cuenca is in charge of the development of policies and projects to promote employment, entrepreneurship and training for prevent unemployment in youth population. More than a third part of the population in Cuenca remains in the group of youth people between 18 to 35 years old. Cuenca has an unemployment rate of 23 % in total, but youth unemployment rate remains near to 50 %, close to the average of this rate for the rest of the country.</p>
Searched partners	<p>Looking for 4 EU partners with 5 young participants able to participate in 2 events of 8 days of interchange (one in Cuenca and other in other EU country) and for working with young people in intercultural interchange and with focus around skills and competences pro emancipation. We have interest to focus this mobility action in a joint validation of a collaborative approach to explore and interchange good practices among young people for further emancipation good practices and share them with Europeans under the same problem. Also we have interest in a joint intercultural interchange to produce reflections of youth people about management of emancipation, techniques for self-esteem, creativity and co-creation for innovative emancipation approaches)</p>
